

# Computer Science and Cybersecurity Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

Many of the desirable skills overlap with the Business BAS degree program, so it could make sense to create a concentration in CS/IT under this degree program.

Next, Nelson Stewart gave an update on the IT/Cybersecurity degree programs. The presentation included updates on new EC Council content as well as the application process for the NSA CAE. Lori Anderson emphasized the Escambia County School District would always welcome PSC to come to their classrooms to recruit and promote our programs.
